As some of you know I have been forced to change jobs after the incident where the cooks scorched my face setting fire to aerosols with their cigarette lighters. A period of constant harassment ensued.

Two young men were hired and the very first night they worked there one of the young men, for no reason, whatsoever, began to try to pick a fight. This went on for several evenings with the supervisors doing absolutely nothing, even criticizing me because I was irritated by the young man's so-called humor.

Then one evening he brought an ax to work and threatened me with it. That night he followed me and another co-worker home throwing rocks at us. When I confronted him and asked him what in the hell he thought he was doing, that he couldn't throw rocks at people, he stated he could do anything he wanted to to me and I couldn't do a damned thing about it. And he again threatened me with the ax.

I called in the police and they ordered them to stay away from me on the street, but could do nothing about the harassment at work.

The abuse continued and I was forced to find work elsewhere, as sooner or later the young man's actions would have gone too far. I will be losing approximately 35¢ an hour and seven or eight hours a week, where I was making around \$800 a month. I will now be only making about \$600 or less.

We still hope to keep VOICES going but we have been putting off many necessities in the last year. Linda needs an eye exam, and I need dental work. But no other action could be taken than what we have done.

The Dark Ones were trying to force me into a confrontation where I would have done this young man serious harm, and I was not about to fall into such a trap.

The Dark Ones are extremely angry that we have destroyed the Ashtarian attempt to take over Earth, and are beginning to attack many of their workers who are spreading false teachings to interfere with The Awakening. But nothing will stop The Awakening. As we have said before, we can be delayed, but we cannot be stopped. NOTHING WILL STOP US!

THE SPIRITS SPEAK

This is an interview with the Spirit of Elvis Presley. The questions were written by Sasa Rakezic. The interview was done while The Polleys were living in Ellsworth, Maine. The interview originally appeared in the Yugoslavian magazine, VREME, September 14, 1992.

1. How do you see the affairs in the media concerned with guessings that you are still alive?

A. At first I found these rather humorous, but as time passed they became more and more disgusting.

2. There are some cases of people who saw your ghost image, like you are some kind of modern pop-media saint (as described in the book "ELVIS AFTER LIFE," by Raymond A. Moody.) What is your opinion on this phenomena?

A. In some cases when it was felt I could be of some good to someone if I came and gave them counsel, I have answered the pleas of their Loved Ones and gone to these individuals who have called upon me because it was felt I was the only one they would listen to. I have been of help to some, and for this I am grateful. But I am not worthy of such work, and I do not do it too often. I was not a saintly man. I failed in life. I could not take the pressure of fame. I hurt myself, and, those around me by seeking escape in chemical bliss. I should not be looked upon as one worthy of such manifestations. I do these things to help pay some of the debts I owe mankind because I did not speak when I had the popularity that would make my words carry weight. Nor, did I lead a life that was worthy of praise and admiration. I had a great talent but I abused it, seeking with it only my own betterment and not the betterment of all mankind.

3. Pop-Analysts think that your music was softened and lost its original power as you went in the army. Is this true?

A. I would not say so. I think some of my later work was some of my better. It was certainly more of my own because as I became more famous I could select those things that I liked rather than sing material taken from others who could not complain because we used it.

4. Did you meet spirits of other deceased rock stars before you were born again? What did they tell you if you did?

A. Of course I met other performers! One of the greatest joys of The Spirit Realm, once you get used to its existence, is the talents of those people dwelling there. I performed with and for many I admired. There is a song that says 'Oh, what a band in Heaven,' and it is absolutely true! Some of the most unbelievable performances can occur there. I still sometimes journey to The Spirit Realm as my physical form sleeps, to entertain those weary in Spirit. In Spirit performers do not talk much about their talents. Each is aware of the limits of his or her own talent and how they succeeded or failed in the use of it. I was greeted very warmly by most. There were a few that had some legitimate complaints about me, which I was obliged to acknowledge. But these differences were soon settled and it was not long before I was on good terms with all.

5. What do you think of your career from this point? What was worst, and what was the most

thrilling aspect of it?

A. I look back on my career with many joys. Its only shortcomings were caused by my own fears and jealousy and greed. I could have done much more if I could have better handled the circumstances of my fame. At first I loved the attention of my fans. But in the end I came to resent and fear it, seeking sometimes just a few moments of privacy; times when I could just be a good old country boy truck driver, who liked to sing and not a well known celebrity. It is hard to explain to others the pressure of fame, the cost of fame. When the point comes that you no longer belong to yourself but to the public, it's a pressure that breaks weak men, and I was a man who sought fame but did not have the character to sustain its pressures.

6. What was the idea of your music that makes you so influential for the generations of people on the planet?

A. I wish you could tell me that! My music was just the music of the common people, the thoughts and joys of those who had the lowest stations in life. Many of my first songs were stolen in part or whole from black performers who I had listened to constantly, and copied directly. Why this music struck such a response through me and not others, who were performing it as well, I cannot tell you. I do not know. I can only say it was the music of the people, the common people, and perhaps this was its greatest appeal. But why I personally, became the greatest focal point of that appeal will be a mystery to me forever. For there were others far more talented than myself, who were virtually ignored, especially of the colored who should have gotten far more credit for their work than I.

7. Can you describe the very essence of the idea of Elvis Presley?

If I had to choose one word, one thought, it would have to be "Americana." I think I was pictured in the minds of most as the image of the American male of my era. A very poor image, but the perceived and popular image.

8. Will you develop your music talent in your new body, or will you find some different challenge?

A. I will still carry with me my musical talent from lifetime to lifetime. Once evolved, something like that will never pass away. We are the grand sum of all those things that we have learned through our passage in time. But in my new life other talents will be dominant, other skills will be used. If I entertain people with music at all, it will only be in private with a few close friends. I think it will be several lifetimes before I could ever make myself a public entertainer again. Though if things go well, and I help accomplish that which we want to do, I may gather some public note. It will be for far more important things than singing rock and roll.

9. Could you tell us what you look like now, how old you are, your name, and where you live?

A. As I want to keep my new life and my old one separate I do not want to give my exact location or name. I will say I am now of Spanish descent with a few touches of Native American, and living somewhere in South

America. To say any more than that would start a mad dash of the ignorant and feeble-minded in the hopes of finding me and again exploiting my talents. Be assured if anyone from that area comes forward and claims either that they have found my reincarnation or are my reincarnation, they are liars, and only attempting to fool the public for personal gain. This one, alone, through whom I speak knows where and who I am, and no bribe or threat would induce him to betray my trust. Elvis Presley is dead. That existence is ended. The new one is separate and distinct and the new living form will never know of its past until it again returns to The Spirit World and becomes one with all that it is. This Soul is not ready yet for the great burden of knowing who and what it was before. It will have to pass through many lifetimes before it could endure such pain and sorrow. Let the past sleep with the past and let the future sleep with the future.

10. What are your comments on the t.v. movie recently shown in the United States that shows Colonel Parker is a crook and was instrumental in encouraging your addictions, and often abused and betrayed you?

A. Like all men, Colonel Parker had his faults. I will not say that he was a saintly man, but I want to make two things very clear; he never encouraged my addiction. For his own reasons he always opposed anything that threatened my talents, made it difficult for me to perform. And as far as any betrayal went, I betrayed him in many ways far more often than he betrayed me. Very little was done without my consent though it was sometimes given grudgingly. I had a deep respect for the Colonel, something I had for very few men. He had a great talent in his own right and I would never have become popular without using his gift and the current public portrayals of him as they have been reported to me, are unjust and cruel. And it is said that in this production I am portrayed as a crying, helpless whimp. I guarantee you on my worst day I am never that....not in front of the Colonel at least.

11. Are you satisfied with the way your granddaughter is being raised?

A. How my granddaughter is being raised is none of my business. That is my daughter's concern. As I have no personal knowledge of what has now occurred, it is not for me to comment. I do wish the blood suckers in the tabloids would get out of my daughter's life, and let her solve her own problems without making them part of the public record and interfering with her life. The animals that write for these papers are the lowest form of human filth, feeding the American desire for perversion with any lie they can tell that they think they can get away with.

12. Any comments on the famous flying Elvises parachute team?

A. Only that I wish each and every one of them happy and safe landings.

13. What is your opinion of the postage stamp with your picture?

A. I am both honored and disgusted. It is hard to put my feelings into words. I do not think my talent, alone, as a singer made me worthy to be so honored. I think I was far too lacking in character to be put before the public in such a manner. The youth of today need better heroes than drug addicts and failures.

ASHTARIAN SORROW CONTINUES

OCTOBER 28, 1994

I have received two reports from Galactic Command that upset me. One, another Ashtarian ship has been destroyed trying to sneak into the solar system. Again it was a small ship.

It was blown up by its own crew rather than be captured.

Secondly my greatest fears were realized when it was reported that the bio containers retrieved from the previous ship contained Bubonic plague.

Having the same thought I did, The Galactic Forces compared it to the strains now infecting parts of India. It is the same exact strain! The Council was thrown into turmoil. Twenty-three of the families represented want to sue for peace under the terms the Galactic Community have offered, the rest want to fight on at any cost.
